In some ways I'm a bit more worried about Harry because he is not as happy as Tom. But I also worry about Tom because he has not got any plans for his future. Yes, life is hard living with teenagers, but I'll miss them when they leave home.

Natural disasters like earthquakes, tornado, tsunami and floods happen more frequently nowadays. There are many reasons why they occur, but the main one is related to human activity on Earth which often has a negative impact on our environment.

All kinds of disasters are usually very damaging. Many dwellings, roads and even whole streets and cities are ruined. The number of victims usually terrifies as hundreds or even thousands of people get injured or die in disasters. However, each disaster has a different nature.

The British Museum

Sir Hans Sloane collected everything: rare books and pictures, precious stones, stuffed animals, birds, butterflies, ancient things. He was a great collector. He died in 1753 and the King bought his collection for £ 20,000. This was the beginning of the British Museum.

It was opened to the public in 1759 and was the first public museum.

The British Museum is a treasure house of old, interesting and magnificent objects collected all over the world. A winged lion is the heaviest exhibit in the Museum. It weighs 16 tons. The tallest exhibit is the totem pole which is 11 meters high. The stone tools from Africa are the oldest exhibits. They are more than a million years old.

The British Museum has a rare Roman silver mirror. There are about half a million coins in the British Museum. You can also admire beautiful vases, amphorae, pots made of white porcelain from China, Greece and other countries.

Today, The British Museum has grown to become one of the largest museums in the world, covering an area of over 92,000m² (990,000sq.ft.). There are nearly one hundred galleries open to the public, representing 2 miles (3.2km) of exhibition space. The Museum is now looking forward to its next major building project, the World Conservation and Exhibition Centre. This project was announced in July 2007 and is expected for completion by 2013.
